Hijaab

Allah has made the adherence to the Hijab/pardah a manifestation for chastity and modesty: O Prophet! Tell your wives and your daughters and the women of the believers that they should draw down their shawls over them. Q33:59______ Therefore all the mothers/sisters are humbly requested to wear Hijaab (Dupattah/Niqab) upon dropping / collecting their chid/ren so then we feel proud that we are acquiring Islamic knowledge, teaching it and our children practising and acting upon it. Also our generation will follow our good acts; therefore Allah almighty will accept our righteous deeds and will be pleased with us.

Masaa'il

- One can do Tayammum when water is not available or when the use of water is injurious to health.
- You can do masah on the Waterproof Socks for 24 hours when you are at home and for 72 hours when you are a traveller.
- When you are in the state of no $wud\hat{U}$ then you are holding the minor unseen impurity. When you are in the state of no *Ghusl* then you are holding the major unseen impurity.
- If a person is unable to have purity by $wud\hat{U}$, Ghusl or Tayammum to offer Salah irrespective of whether the means of purification are not available or it is because of some sickness and the salah time will expire soon then he/she should offer the salah without the purification. Once the person purifies him/herself later, he/she should repeat the salah. (Bahishti Zewar for males page:72)
- Entry in to mosque for a woman in the state of her period is forbidden.
